Highlights from the June 2005 Delegates Meeting

- Dr. James Holt, AKC's Legislative Liaison, spoke to the Delegates about AKC's decision to support the principles in the Pet Animal Welfare Statute. The full text of his comments appears in the meeting minutes.
- A number of amendments to the Field Trial Rules were proposed that would create a National Amateur Field Trial Championship and a National Amateur Field Trial Championship stake for Cocker Spaniels and English Cocker Spaniels. The necessary rule changes will be voted on at the September 2005 meeting.
- There was also a proposed amendment read that would enable shows in a cluster to have the same closing date. Currently shows held on different days often are required to have different closing dates, which is confusing to exhibitors. The rule amendment will also be voted on at the September 2005 meeting.
- The second quarter AKC 2005 Community Achievement Awards were announced. These awards are given to clubs and individuals who have made outstanding contributions to public education or canine legislation. The honorees are: Patte Klecan, from the Rio Grande Kennel Club and John Fredericks, from the Vegas Valley
