

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height division. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard and jumpers with weaves classes.

HEIGHT MEASUREMENTS

Dogs without a permanent or temporary height card must be measured prior to running. The judge will be available for measurements in the morning between 8:45 and 9:15.

The following obstacles will conform to and shall be used according to the requirements specified in the AKC *Regulations for Agility Trials*:

FROM NORTH & WEST VIA ROUTE 495 SOUTH

- Route 495 South becomes Route 25 East just after 495 Exit 1.
- Continue on Route 25 East over the Bourne Bridge/Cape Cod Canal and into the Bourne Rotary.
- Go 3/4 of the way around the rotary and exit onto Route 6A (green road sign says "To Hyannis & Provincetown").
- Stay on the main road and turn RIGHT at the traffic lights.
- Go straight through the blinking yellow light and merge left onto Route 6 EAST.
- Approximately 22 miles on Route 6 East and take Exit 9B onto Route 134 NORTH.
- 1/2 mile on Route 134 and turn LEFT at the traffic lights onto Bob Crowell Road.
- 2/10 mile and turn LEFT at the *AGILITY* sign into Johnny Kelley Park.

FROM WEST VIA 195 EAST

- Take Exit 22B and follow exit signs to CAPE COD.
- Exit ramp merges into Route 25 East.
- Follow directions above.

FROM NORTH VIA ROUTE 3 SOUTH

- Route 3 South and over the Sagamore Bridge/Cape Cod Canal onto Route 6 East.
- Approximately 22 miles on Route 6 East and take Exit 9B onto Route 134 NORTH.
- 1/2 mile on Route 134 and turn LEFT at the traffic lights onto Bob Crowell Road.
- 2/10 mile and turn LEFT at the *AGILITY* sign into Johnny Kelley Park.

FROM CAPE COD POINTS EAST VIA ROUTE 6 WEST

- Route 6 West to Exit 9B onto Route 134 NORTH
- 1/2 mile on Route 134 and turn LEFT at the traffic lights onto Bob Crowell Road.
- 2/10 mile and turn LEFT at the *AGILITY* sign into Johnny Kelley Park.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.

MATCH REGULATIONS—NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this match, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

THE MATCH COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this event.

PARTICIPATING DOGS must be twelve months of age or older and must be registered with The American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

THE MATCH SITE will be open on Sunday October 30, 2005 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITORS' DOGS and CHILDREN AT THE MATCH SITE must be under control and not permitted to roam. Any exhibitor whose dog or child engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Match Committee, be asked to leave the match site. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates at all times except when in the ring or in the designated warm-up area. Puppies under 6 months of age are prohibited from the match site. Pinch collars, citronella collars, electric and dummy electric collars, gentle leaders and similar halter collars are also prohibited on the match grounds. The site will be monitored and offenders may be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.

APPROPRIATE VACCINATIONS, as recommended by your veterinarian, should be given to ensure your dog is free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases.

COPIES OF JUMP HEIGHT CARDS must be received by the Match Secretary prior to the Closing Date or presented at the Check-in Table on the day of the match. Otherwise, the dog must be measured by the judge prior to competing.

MATCH REGULATIONS—NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS (Con't)

ENTRIES

ENTRIES MUST be completed and signed using an official AKC entry form (or copy thereof) that includes the official AKC Agreement. Other Forms will not be accepted.

MAKE CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE to Cape Cod Kennel Club, Inc. All fees are to be payable in U.S. Dollars.

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES (including those without fees, without a signature or without the AKC Agreement) will not be accepted.

POST DATED AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

FAX, TELEPHONE, AND EMAIL ENTRIES will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS are the owner's responsibility and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the match has closed.

A MAXIMUM OF TEN ENTRIES PER ENVELOPE IS ALLOWED. Envelopes/transactions with more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to sender.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as possible after the match closes or the limit is reached, and will include confirmation notices.

ENTRY FEE REFUND POLICIES

Refund requests must be made to the Match Secretary and must include owner's or agent's name and mailing address.

General refund requests must be received by the Match Secretary prior to the closing date on Friday October 7, 2005 at 6:00 p.m. Refunds will not be given for entries withdrawn after that date/time, with the exception of bitches in season.

Bitches in season shall not be eligible to participate and there will be a refund of entry fees, provided a Veterinarian's note accompanies your refund request AND the request is received prior to the date of match.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Match Committee.

If the match cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, entry fees will not be refunded.

MATCH RULES

The match shall be conducted under the AKC rules and regulations for agility trials. Single copies of the latest edition of the *Regulations for Agility Trials* and *Agility Judges Guidelines* may be obtained from THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB, 5580 CENTERVIEW DRIVE, SUITE 200, RALEIGH, NC 27606-3390, or at www.akc.org.

MOVE-UPS

As a result of qualifying for an agility title, dogs may be moved to a higher class at the request of the owner, provided the request is made in writing to the Match Secretary **no later than noon of Monday, October 24, 2005**. Move-ups will be accepted by email or mail, but not by phone or fax.

MOTOR VEHICLE ENTRY WAIVER

All persons attending this Match hereby waive any claim for damages against Cape Cod Kennel Club or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

ZERO TOLERANCE

Exhibitors who do not clean up after their dogs will be excused from the match. In such cases, no refunds will be made.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
