Helyne & Kevin Medeiros' Multiple Group winning Am. & Can Ch. Bee Serious Eleventh Hour went Group 1 at Bennington KC, Group 4 at Saratoga KC, Group 2 at Mid Coast KC 1, Group 1 at Mid Coast KC2 and BOB at Westchester KC. El was shown less than 8 months in 2005 to #3 Pointer (breed system). Another Lord Jim son MBIS Aust. & NZ Grand Ch. Chesterhopes Lets Be Serious won Best In Show at the National Dog Show this month in NZ, this is their largest All Breed Dog Show. A Jim daughter is currently #1 All Breeds in Hong Kong, and a Jim Grandson just won the Canadian Pointer National Specialty.

At South Shore Kennel Club on 09/16/05, Susan Carlson's Shiht-zu, Junior, earned a 181.5 in Novice B.

Mikki Castonguay's golden retriever Toryglen Morning Star Pirate CD, RA, CGC, ASCA CD, TDI-CTD, TT (KIDD) completed his rally advanced title at Wachusett KC on 08/18/05.

Dianne McDonough's golden retriever, Toryglen A Dream of Flight CD, RN, CGC, (Joy) completer her rally novice title at North Shore KC on 06/18/05 and her CD at Lake's Region KC on 07/13/05. Dianne's golden retriever Toryglen Morning Star Day Dream UD, RAE, CGC, ASCA CD, TDI-CTD (Hope) completer her Utility Dog title at Shrewsbury DTC on 03/13/05. Hope finished her ASCA CD at the ASCA Colors of Summer trial on 06/04/05. Hope has also been really busy with Rally, completing all 4 AKC Rally titles. Rally Novice at York County KC on 05/06/05. Rally Advanced at Greenwich KC on 06/11/05. Rally Excellent at Eastern English Springer Spaniel Specialty on 06/24/05. Rally Advanced Excellent at Wachusett KC on 08/18/05. The RAE title requires qualifying in both rally advanced and rally excellent at the same show 10 times. Hope qualified every time she showed, and completed her RAE title with first place finishes and perfect 100 scores in both rally advanced and rally excellent.

Lesley Little's Vizsla Teddy (aka CH Szerenade Rhythm of the Tide) finished his show champion at 11 months at the Trap Falls Kennel Club in Springfield on 8/25 with his third major. Special thanks to Marie Hannah for handling (and winning his first major!) when his breeder wasn't available.

Jackie Owens' Aussie, Jingles (Maine-Ly Troubador's Noel) got her 3rd leg for her CD Title on August 25 at the Trap Falls KC Trials in Springfield. The next day Jingles took 1st place in the Novice B class.

Cortney Oliver's Tilly, CH Graecroft Seasyde Blue Moon CDX TDX MH AX AXJ earned her Rally Novice (RN) title at the Wine Country shows with scores of 91, 94 and 93.

Bronwyn Bresnahan and her German Shepherd "Rommel" attended their first specialty at the German Shepherd Dog Club of Central Massachusetts Specialty October 8th and received a qualifying obedience score of 198 in Novice B. They were awarded 1st place German Shepherd, 1st place all breed, and Highest Scoring German Shepherd in Trial.

Donna O'Connell's English Cocker Spaniel, "Tyler" - Cobblestone Tuscany Corazon was Reserve Best in Sweeps at the ECSCA Specialty at the Morris & Essex KC show. At Hatboro KC the next day, Tyler was WD & BOW for a 3 pt. major. This was Tyler's second major with limited showing.

Charleen Maxim's Shiba Inu, Cape Cod's Native Son - "Sonny", took two 4 point majors and 2 reserves to 4 point majors his first weekend out at the Mar/Apr Syracuse Leatherstocking cluster. Sonny's second weekend out at the Cranberry Cluster brought him 3 BOB wins and a reserve for an additional 5 points. Sonny followed up his 3rd weekend out at the competitive Wine Country Circuit with a major reserve and a BOW 5 point major to finish his Championship in style from the Bred-By Exhibitor class. Charleen's Shiba Inu, River Wind's Like A Hurricane - "Izzy" picked up her 1st point at the Cranberry Cluster. Just to prove this wasn't a fluke she went on to the Wine Country Circuit and picked up WB for a 5 point major and followed up with a back to back BOW/BOS over specials 5 point major. She ended the Wine Circuit weekend with a reserve to a 5 major. The following weekend she went on to the Shiba National at Morris & Essex and placed 3rd in a very competitive open bitch class. Needless to say we are very proud of our kids her at Cape Cod Shibas.

Maria Hannah's Shelly earned her RA at the Doberman Pinscher Club of Houston with a 3rd place. At the Doberman Pinscher club of America Nationals she earned her first Rally Excellent leg with a 4 th place. She also did a great job performing in the DPCA National Top Twenty Obedience event! P.S. Texas is one long drive!

Debra Carlson's Ch. Ladys Spirit von Renaissance CDX, MX, MXJ finished his MX at the Pioneer Valley Kennel Club on September 17th. Her Lady's Hawke von Renaissance CDX, MX, AXJ finished his MX at the Cheshire Kennel Club on October 15th. Both boys double q'd at the Cheshire Kennel Club on October 15th in the pouring rain.
