MASSFED Opposes PAWS Legislation

July 18, 2005

After polling the Federation member clubs, the MassFed Board of Directors voted to OPPOSE the PAWS Legislation. This bill would cause the AWA, for the first time, to affect hobby breeders who sell directly to the public and could also impact those who help with their clubs' breed rescue programs. Below you will find a document which includes the full addresses, phone and fax numbers of Massachusetts Congressmen. We are encouraging faxes rather than USPS mail due to mail delays in Washington, D.C. We are asking MA Congressmen NOT to co-sponsor this legislation. Also, below you will find a document which includes all members of the Agriculture Committee (Senate & House) and, again, we are encouraging faxes rather than USPS mail to register opposition to
